Day Visits

Day visits are held throughout our site and your location depends on your chosen topic. Day visits are held in our Barn, Archers' Hall or in our Longhouse.

While the emphasis is on outdoor activities during your visit, we also provide access to a dedicated indoor space.

- Standard day visits are self-catered, but extended day visits include catering: picnic lunch, snack and a themed banquet dinner or fiesta.

Prices vary according to season. All residential visits are fully catered, include all activities led by our experienced team and a themed evening banquet or fiesta evening.

Notes

- If your group size exceeds our maximum numbers, please get in touch with us as we may still be able to accommodate your school by booking out more than one of our accommodation areas.
- We provide free places for adults within our 1:8 adult/child ratio but you can bring additional adults at an additional cost.
- There is a reduced cost for non-residential children.
- Adults attending for the day only or attending the banquet/fiesta evening will incur an additional charge of £15 per adult.

Residential Facilities

Manor House:

Bookings taken for Ufton History and Ufton Outdoors only.

Depending on the size of your group, you'll be allocated either the North or South Wing for smaller groups (20 – 40 children), or the entire Manor House for larger groups over 41 children. Your group will be allocated to one of the following:

- a. The North Wing sleeps 27 children and 6 adults
- b. The South Wing sleeps 40 children and 7 adults
- c. The entire Manor House sleeps 67 children and 14 adults

The Manor House is available for both <u>Ufton History</u> and <u>Ufton Outdoors</u> topics. Your group will have use of a dining room, communal areas and surrounding grounds throughout your stay.

Woodland Cabins:

Bookings taken for Ufton Outdoors and Ufton Adventure only.

Our woodland Cabins are located by our private woodland, providing a true connection to nature that the children will love to explore. Included in your residential stay will be exclusive use of our catering cabin and 6 sleeping cabins accommodating a total of 38 children and 6 adults.

The Woodland Cabins are available to book for our <u>Ufton Outdoors</u> and <u>Ufton Adventure</u> programme only.

The Longhouse:

Seasonal bookings taken for Ufton Outdoors and Ufton Adventure only.

Children and adults will sleep in our Longhouse in sleeping bags as a communal sleeping space.

Treehouse camping is recommended for smaller groups and one-night stays, accommodating up to 20 children (25 children for younger year groups due to limited space) and 4 adults.

Treehouse Camping within the Longhouse offers a seasonal residential experience and is available from the

1st April to 31st October for our <u>Ufton Outdoors</u> and <u>Ufton Adventure</u> programmes only.

How to book

1. Contact us to make a booking

2. Secure your booking

A no-obligation date reservation can be held for 7 days. We are unfortunately unable to hold dates for longer than 7 days. Once your date has been confirmed, we will provide you with your booking form and deposit invoice to secure your booking. You will have two weeks to complete your booking form and evidence your deposit payment (20% of the total cost of your visit).

Dates are often booked far in advance so we recommend you reserve dates as soon as possible.

3. Information Exchange

Final children and adult numbers will be required at least 4 weeks ahead of your visit to ensure the accuracy of your final invoice, with payment due 7 days prior to your arrival. We will also request completion of sleeping arrangements and dietary information in advance so we can ensure an enjoyable and safe experience.
